80,000 kids transported safely

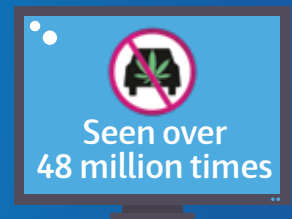


Our car seat training ensured 80,000 kids were transported safely
