



## **Installing an Infant Only Seat: Universal Anchorage System (UAS) & Seat Belt Methods**

### **Before you start**

- **Always follow your vehicle manual and car seat manual instructions.**
- Never install an infant-only seat on the front passenger seating position with an active airbag.

### **If using the Universal Anchorage System (UAS) Method**

#### **Step 1:**

Locate the universal anchor bars.

#### **Step 2:**

Place the base on the vehicle seat.

#### **Step 3:**

Ensure the base is reclined to the correct level, by checking the level indicator on the base when the vehicle is parked on level ground.

#### **Step 4:**

Ensure the UAS is routed through the correct belt path.

#### **Step 5:**

Attach the UAS to the lower universal anchor bars.

#### **Step 6:**

Apply pressure to the base with your hand and pull the UAS tight.

#### **Step 7:**

Test for tightness by holding both sides of the base at the belt path and gently moving it from side to side. There should be no more than one inch of movement.

#### **Step 8:**

Attach the infant seat to the base. Adjust the handle on the infant seat to the correct position according to the car seat manual instructions.

### **If using the Seat Belt Method**

#### **Step 1:**

Thread the seat belt through the correct belt path in the base, according to the car seat manual instructions.

#### **Step 2:**

Buckle the seat belt.



**Step 3:**

Now lock the seat belt by slowly pulling the webbing all the way out. Let it retract a short distance. Then tug on the seat belt. It should now be locked.

**Step 4:**

Apply pressure to the centre of the base with your hand and pull the seat belt tight.

**Step 5:**

Test for tightness by holding both sides of the base at the belt path and gently moving it from side to side. There should be no more than one inch of movement.

**Step 6:**

Attach the infant seat to the base. Adjust the handle on the infant seat to the correct position according to the car seat manual instructions.

Some infant-only seat bases have built-in lock-offs for locking the seat belt. **Always follow the car seat manual instructions.**
