



Securing a Child in an Infant-only Seat

Before you start:

- Adjust the harness straps so that they are level or below the child's shoulders while seated
- Always follow manufacturer's instructions when positioning a child in the infant-only seat

Step 1:

Place the infant in the car seat and put the harness straps over each shoulder, then click both metal latches into the buckle.

Step 2:

Adjust the harness so that it is the same length on both sides.

Step 3:

Tighten the harness so that no more than one finger fits between the harness and the child's collarbone

Step 4:

Buckle the chest clip and adjust it to the underarm level.

Step 5:

If there's no head support for a newborn, place a rolled receiving blanket on each side of the infant's head to give them added support. Blankets are no longer needed once the child is able to hold up their head unassisted.

NOTE:

- It is not recommended to use any aftermarket products that did not come with the infant seat
- Remember that nothing should be placed under or behind the child
