



## Securing a Child in a Rear-Facing Child Car Seat

### Before you start:

- Adjust the harness straps so they are level or below the child's shoulders while seated
- Always follow manufacturer's instructions when positioning a child in the child car seat

### Step 1:

Place the child in the car seat and put the harness straps over the shoulders, then click both metal latches into the buckle.

### Step 2:

Adjust the harness so that it is the same length on both sides.

### Step 3:

Tighten the harness so that no more than one finger fits between the harness and the child's collarbone.

### Step 4:

Buckle the chest clip and adjust it to the underarm level.
