

Are you using the right car seat for your child?



Rear-facing

AGE: Up to one year

WEIGHT: 10 kg (22 lb.)



It is recommended that children remain rear-facing as long as possible within the manufacturer's rear-facing weight limit.



Forward-facing

AGE: Over one year

WEIGHT: 10 kg to 18 kg
(22 to 40 lb.)

It is recommended that children under 4 years old remain in a harnessed forward-facing child seat as long as possible within the manufacturer's weight limit.



Booster seat

AGE: Up to 9th birthday

WEIGHT: Over 18 kg (40 lb.)

HEIGHT: Up to 145 cm (4'9")

It is recommended that children remain in a booster seat until they reach the height of 4'9" or 145 cm and are within the manufacturer's weight limit.
